



HESTON II CABINET

Shown is one of two matching cabinets with Mist bird's eye maple veneer panels, framed in Raven walnut. Bi-fold doors fold back completely against the sides to facilitate access. Internal flaps are supported by a pull-out shelf; all vertical interior surfaces of the cabinet are leather-lined, while all horizontal surfaces are in Parapan®, a resilient material which is easily wiped clean. One of the two cabinets contains a wine cooler; the necessary ventilation grille complements the design of the Loop handles.

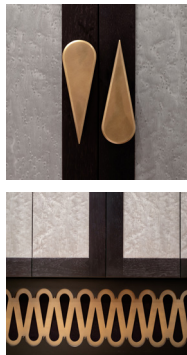

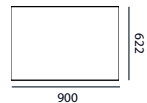

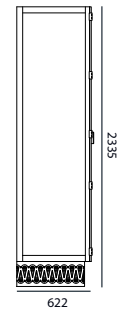
Plan
